

## 2019 Season Rules and Regulations

DURING THE 2019 SEASON, FARMERS MARKET MEMBERS ARE ALLOWED TO SETUP AT THE MARKET AT ANY TIME. HOWEVER, SETTING UP ON SATURDAYS FROM 8-1 IS ENCOURAGED AS IT WILL BE ADVERTISED—MAY THROUGH SEPTEMBER.

This market was created to provide local farmers and gardeners an outlet for the produce and plants they grow. Home made items such as jellies, pickled fruit or vegetables, cakes, pies and handmade crafts may also be featured at this outlet. It was founded to provide a place for citizens to purchase locally grown or made items. There is no charge for booth space at this time.

The market shall be open Monday though Saturday until 7pm. It will be the responsibility of each seller to be sure their area is clean when they leave! Sellers may open the market immediately once their application is approved.

Regional farmers (within 40 mile radius) who produce fruit, vegetables, fish, meat, eggs, dairy, honey, preserves, plants, and other foods may sell at the Springhill Farmers Market. All items sold at this market MUST be grown, raised, foraged, caught, or otherwise produced by the seller or their families. Any exceptions must be approved by the advisory board. Middlemen or brokers are NOT allowed. Fish MUST be approved by Wildlife & Fisheries Dept.

Any scales used MUST be USDA certified.

Springhill Farmers Market Advisory Board members will routinely visit growers to make sure that what they sell insures product integrity and is grown in their fields. NO EXCEPTIONS. NO PEDDLERS.

Posting signs with the name of your farm and prices of your items is encouraged.

NO SELLER SHALL USE PRICE CUTTING TACTICS TO COMPETE WITH OTHER SELLERS. NO SELLER WILL BE ALLOWED TO DICTATE TO OTHER SELLERS ANY RULES OR PRICES. ALL SELLERS WILL AGREE WITH EACH OTHER ON THE PRICES AND PRICES OF THE SAME PRODUCT WILL BE THE SAME. PRICING WILL BE IN LINE WITH, BUT NOT NECESSARILY THE SAME AS LOCAL SUPERMARKETS.

The mission of the this market is to support our local farmers with their home grown goods and not to compete with our supermarkets!
